Introduction

Description

The enzyme from the fungus *Aspergillus fumigatus* can also prenylate other tryptophan-containing cyclic dipeptides. Prenylation occurs mainly at C-2, but also at C-3. Involved in the biosynthetic pathways of several indole alkaloids such as tryprostatins, cyclotryprostatins, spirotryprostatins, fumitremorgins and verruculogen.
