Introduction

Description Hawthorn (*Crataegus* species) is a small tree or shrub and a member of the rose family. It was hung over the doorway in the Middle Ages to prevent the entry of evil spirits. By the early 1800s, American doctors recognized the herb's medicinal properties and began using it to treat circulatory disorders and respiratory illnesses.

Applications Hawthorn is claimed to maintain healthy collagen matrices of arterial walls so that the vessels remain elastic. It is used to normalize heart rhythm, reduce the likelihood and severity of angina attacks, and prevent cardiac complications in elderly patients with influenza and pneumonia.
