Introduction

Description Magnesium Ascorbyl Phosphate, sometimes called MAP, is a white or yellowish powdered substance. MAP can be enzymatically cleaved to ascorbic acid by the enzyme phosphatase in the skin, which plays a physiological role. This means that it can enter into the cell and be converted into vitamin C.
