Description

Methyl butyrate is a natural ester compound widely distributed in pineapple, apple, kiwi and other fruits. As a food-grade flavoring agent, it features a pleasant fruity aroma reminiscent of apple, banana and pineapple notes, and is commonly used in the formulation of artificial rum and fruit essences. This product is produced through esterification of methanol and butyric acid, meeting food-grade quality standards for use in food flavoring applications.
