Auxins are a class of essential plant hormones that regulate cell elongation, root initiation, apical dominance and tropic responses. This product encompasses natural and synthetic auxin compounds including indole-3-acetic acid (IAA) and related derivatives. Auxins play critical roles in promoting rooting, fruit development and vascular tissue differentiation, and are widely used in agriculture, horticulture and plant tissue culture to enhance rooting of cuttings, regulate plant growth patterns and improve crop productivity.
