Arabinogalactan endo-beta-1,4-galactanase is an enzyme with system name arabinogalactan 4-beta-D-galactanohydrolase. The enzyme specifically hydrolyses (1->4)-beta-D-galactosidic linkages in type I arabinogalactans.
